Shimizu Sensei was (until 1969) one of the last Uchi Deshi (living in the house of the Master) and experienced the highest level of development of Aikido with O-Sensei Ueshiba. After the death of O-Sensei in 1969 Shimizu Sensei founded his own style in Tokyo, and named it after his birthplace, Tendoryu (School of heavenly Path).
